

## **2010 COURSE CATALOG**

Dear Prospective Student,

Thank you for your interest in The School of Principled Consciousness 2010 term of study.

The School offers an innovative one-year program to gain fluency in applying models of integrity to a self-structured project to be completed by each student during his one-year term. New in 2010, The School presents an additional 3-month Program called "Seasonal Project". Students will learn to increase their powers of manifestation in accord with highest ethical models. Correlating each step with its energetic aspect, students learn to comprehend the inherent connection between energetics, intention, action, and outcome. The School of Principled Consciousness exists under the auspices of Fields of Understanding, L.L.C..

Starting February 1<sup>st</sup>, The School offers each student a unique and personalized program. All processes and activities associated with The School are led by Sue Gurnee and Emissary Associates who have previously used the precepts of the lessons to accomplish their project goals without compromise.

The mission of The School of Principled Consciousness is to amplify the spirit of integrity, ethics and mutuality while students engage in project-oriented lessons related to themes honoring nature's brilliance.

### **CURRICULUM**

Under the direction of Sue Gurnee, students choose the individual project they will spend the calendar year completing. All projects will have in common that they serve the focus to sustain nature's brilliance. In this exciting global classroom without boundaries, the impulse is to provide communally beneficial solutions to challenging themes. Each student participates in the advancement of his consciousness as it applies to his project focus. Through the supervised independent course of study, students have access to The School through telephone, email, e-book lectures and distance energy work. The private distance consultations with Sue Gurnee are augmented with twelve or more lectures tailored to each student's individual needs. These sound files are suitable for listening in one's home or while traveling.

In addition, all students of the one-year program are invited to attend three group events, two Group Forums and one Group Project Event. The duration of each event is revised for each term, each lasting 5 days at the most. For the Group Project Event, the choice of group activity is dependent upon student agreement. (For 2010 dates and locations please see below.) These Group Forums and Projects are designed specifically for and open only to current students of the year-long program of The School of Principled Consciousness. Onsite housing and meals are provided for participants as well as recreational activities for inspiration and communion (for sample itinerary please check below).

The private distance consultations for each student with Sue Gurnee take place once a month for one hour and are scheduled by email notification in advance so that adequate preparation is possible. (The intensive days of Group Events replace the private consultations in the respective calendar months). Fields of Understanding's headquarters is a natural setting that gently occupies 125 acres of pristine woodlands and pastures overlooking one of the oldest rivers in the world. Here students can review audio recordings, share

insights with other committed peers, conduct research and review projects from previous students in the Sunset Building. In the evenings, bonfires at the Summit and spur-of-the-moment activities at the House of Five Senses provide additional activity.

Students are encouraged, though not required, to enter The School with someone with whom they can share a project. Thereby on top of their individual learning and consultations with Sue Gurnee, experiences in conscious team work and pursuing a shared project goal can be made. If students enter The School as a project team (number of persons working and learning as a team is limited to two per team), there will be a discount for each of the two tuitions.

Upon completion of the one-year course, students will be given the honor of continuing to participate in the on-going world-wide achievements of future students by acting as Member Emissaries.

Member Emissaries advise and aid students using their increased level of awareness, integrity and power of manifestation gained by satisfactory completion of his individual project using the precepts learned.

### **STUDENT FINANCIAL AID**

The School of Principled Consciousness currently does not have available government sponsored programs or grants for in-need students.

### **SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES**

Considering that students manage multiple commitments, The School is designed for the independent adult learner who requires a highly flexible course structure. It is important, for all concerned that after a student begins The School that he continues until his goal is reached. If this is accomplished before August 22, the remaining portion of the year's tuition fee will be waived and this student may act as a Member Emissary for the rest of the school's term. Upon the unlikely event that a student wishes to withdraw from the year's study, The School requests that the student state, in writing, his reason for leaving. After evaluation, it will be determined if a reimbursement is appropriate. If a student decides to end the program because of extenuating circumstances or those associated with the project's schoolwork, a panel of adjudicators will review the specific circumstances and rule according to the highest outcome for all concerned. If a student's enrollment is terminated by The School for rule violation or non-payment of fees, official notification will be made in writing and no reimbursements will be given.
